Day 1 USA/ KILLARNEY Trans-Atlantic overnight flight from your home airport on the scheduled services of an international airline.

Day 2 KILLARNEY (D) Welcome to beautiful Ireland! Sit back and enjoy your new surroundings as we travel via private motorcoach from Shannon to Killarney, a gem of a town situated in County Kerry, the westernmost part of Ireland. Along the way, we'll stop to view the impressive Cliffs of Moher, rising 400 feet above the Atlantic Ocean. Consisting mainly of beds of shale and sandstone, the cliffs are home to a variety of animals, mostly birds, including the famous Atlantic Puffins. Tonight, join your fellow travelers for a Welcome to Ireland Dinner.

Day 3 KILLARNEY (B) Today, after breakfast, we'll explore the beauty and charm of County Kerry, traditionally known as the 'kingdom.' We'll visit the Tudor-style mansion and grounds of Muckross House and Gardens, built in 1843; as well as, the Folk Museum, where skilled craft workers ply their century's old trade. Here you'll discover the way of life and traditions of the people in Ireland, past and present. This evening is yours to enjoy at your leisure.

Day 4 KILLARNEY (B/L) After breakfast, enjoy a day of splendid scenery as we tour one of Ireland's most popular and beautiful drives, the Ring of Kerry, where mountains, valleys, lakes and sea combine into a breathtaking landscape. On our way to Molls Gap – one of the most dramatic sections of the Ring of Kerry, situated in the heart of the Black Mountains – we'll pass through the peaceful little villages of Killorglin (the gateway to the Ring of Kerry); Cahirciveen ("town of Little Saidhbh"); Waterville ("The Little Whirlpool") – where we'll have lunch; and Sneem ("The Knot in the Ring"). Day 5 WATERFORD (B/D) We'll continue on our excursion through Ireland today – after breakfast, we'll travel along the southern route, stopping at the famous Blarney Castle and its excellent Woolen Mill. For those energetic souls, get ready to experience a delightful ancient custom today – kissing the famous Blarney Stone and be "bestowed with the gift of eloquence." A climb up the steps will lead you to the famous Blarney Stone where you then lead backwards from the parapet walk to participate in this age-old tradition! Next, we're off to the famous Waterford Crystal Factory, home of the world's finest hand-crafted crystal. A real working environment, you'll be able to get up close to the process and see how the beautiful pieces are made. We'll overnight tonight in Waterford.

Day 6 DUBLIN (B) After breakfast, we'll head north to Dublin where, upon arrival, we'll pass by the National Gallery; The Four Courts; Leinster House (seat of the Irish Parliament); and Merrion Square, one of Dublin's largest Georgian squares. We'll also make stops at Freemasons' Hall; St. Patrick's Cathedral, the largest church in Ireland; and Trinity College, Ireland's oldest and most famous University, where you'll see the unique world treasure produced by Celtic monks – the ornately illustrated Book of Kells. Enjoy a free evening tonight to explore Dublin on your own!

Day 7 DUBLIN (B/D) We'll visit two of Ireland's premier attractions today, the National Stud Farm and Japanese Gardens, located in Tully in the beautiful County Kildare. In use as a stud farm since 1900, the 1,000 acre National Stud is home to some of Ireland's finest racehorse thoroughbreds. The Japanese Gardens, situated on the grounds of the farm, were created between 1906-1910 to symbolize the 'Life of Man.' Considered the finest Japanese Gardens in Europe, their significance is not only artistic and horticultural but also philosophical, religious and historical. This evening, we'll bid a fond farewell to Ireland in grand style at Jurys Irish Cabaret, enjoying dinner and a show.

Day 8 DUBLIN/EDINBURGH (B) This morning, we'll transfer from Dublin to Belfast where we'll board the high-speed Stena Line ferry, setting off for the port city of Stranraer, Scotland, which lies at the head of Loch Ryan. Upon arrival, we'll transfer via private motorcoach to Edinburgh, via Loch Lomond. The loch separates the highlands and the lowlands, which creates the most amazing scenery with rounded hills on one side to rugged mountains on the other side. Arriving in Edinburgh in the late afternoon, you'll have time to settle into the hotel before spending an evening at your leisure.

Day 9 EDINBURGH (B) After a Scottish breakfast, our tour this morning will take us for a panoramic city sightseeing tour of Edinburgh. We'll visit the magnificent Edinburgh Castle, dominating the city like no other castle in Scotland and unequalled in the whole of the British Isles; and the Grand Lodge of Scotland. Then it's on to the working church, Rosslyn Chapel (also known for its Masonic symbols), for a tour of this fascinating, historic church. Enjoy a free evening tonight to discover Edinburgh!

Day 10 EDINBURGH (B/D) The morning is yours to enjoy Edinburgh's romantic spell. Spend the day shopping along Princes Street, considered one of the greatest shopping areas in all of Britain. In the afternoon we'll take a tour to St. Andrews, a fascinating town with the oldest University in Scotland and home to the well known R&A, The Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews. Tonight, join your fellow travelers for a Farwell Dinner.

Day 11 EDINBURGH/USA (B) After breakfast, we'll be transferred via private motorcoach to the airport for the return flight home.

Accommodations: If a hotel substitution must be made, a comparable class of hotel will be used. Exchange rates adjustments, if necessary, are made at the time of final payment. The price is also given on a minimum paying passenger amount.
