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**HARGREAVES WINS TOP HONORS FOR POSTER AT NACHRI ANNUAL CONFERENCE**

BOSTON (October 23, 2006) –Rosemary Hargreaves, RN, BSN, Director of Performance Improvement for Shriners Burns Hospital—Boston, was awarded “top poster” and “overall award” for her poster presentation at the National Association of Children’s Hospitals and Related Institutions (NACHRI) Annual Meeting held in Boston in October 8-10.

Hargreaves’ poster titled, “Drive out Fear: Eliminating the Fear of Reporting Medication Errors,” was awarded top poster and best overall honors based on the following criteria: demonstration of a problem or challenge, relevance/interest, results/outcomes, innovation, and design of poster. Hargreaves, who has been with Shriners for 8 years, is charged with ensuring patient safety through performance improvement at the 30-bed pediatric burn hospital.
